

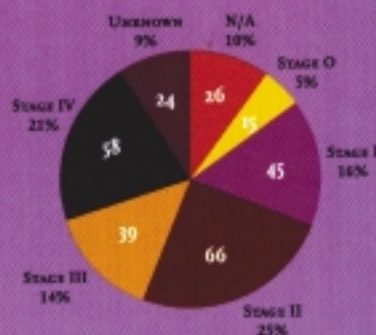
Promoting Cancer Awareness in the Community

Community education is a large part of North Arundel Hospital's oncology initiative. In addition to numerous lectures and health fairs offered throughout the community, screenings for four types of cancer are offered each year. Hundreds of area residents participate in the screenings, which help to promote cancer awareness and aid in detecting the disease at an early stage. In 2000, the following screenings were offered:

Colon Cancer	359 participants
Oral Cancer	36 participants
Prostate Cancer	312 participants
Skin Cancer	43 participants
